

Pre-Employment Transition Services: **Instruction in Self-Advocacy** Ohio Centers for Independent Living

Learn skills needed for greater independence

- Classroom-based
- Duration: Up to 4 hours
- Population: Any student with a disability who needs to develop self-advocacy skills

Service Outcomes:

- Students will have an increased awareness of their rights and responsibilities
- Students will learn leadership skills to support success in the workplace
- Students will explore and connect with leadership or peer mentoring groups in their communities to expand community networks
- Student will complete a form identifying own personal self-advocacy interests and activities to build independence and self-advocacy skills
