

Pre-Employment Transition Services:

Work-Based Learning

Ohio Community Centers for the Deaf

Learn skills needed for greater independence

- Classroom-based
- Duration: Up to 8 hours
- Population: Students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing and need opportunities to learn workplace expectations.

Service Outcomes:

- Students will participate in work site tours and job shadowing experiences at community businesses
- Students will display appropriate work site behaviors
- Students will obtain first-hand knowledge of work settings including: duties, personnel, daily expectation on productivity/output, shifts, accommodations, compensation, unwritten rules of work, etc.
- Students will apply the knowledge and tools they have learned.
- Students will learn the importance of networking and begin documenting resources within their networks.

Work-Based Learning is available statewide to students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. This map reflects service areas where providers will deliver services. OOD will update this information as more services become available and/or service areas expand.
