

Pre-Employment Transition Services: **Instruction in Self-Advocacy** Ohio Sight Centers

Learn skills needed for greater independence

- Classroom-based
- Duration: Up to 4 hours
- Population: Students who are Blind or Visually Impaired and need to develop self-advocacy skills.

Service Outcomes:

- Students will have an increased awareness of their rights and responsibilities
- Students will learn leadership skills to support success in the workplace
- Students will explore and connect with leadership or peer mentoring groups in their communities to expand community networks
- Student will complete a form identifying own personal self-advocacy interests and activities to build independence and self-advocacy skills

Instruction in Self-Advocacy is available statewide to students who are Blind or Visually Impaired. This map reflects service areas where providers will deliver services. OOD will update this information as more services become available and/or service areas expand.
