

Pre-Employment Transition Services: **Job Exploration Counseling** Ohio Sight Centers

Learn skills needed for greater independence

- Classroom-based
- Duration: Up to 8 hours
- Population: Students who are Blind or Visually Impaired and need assistance in learning about career options

Service Outcomes:

- Students will complete interest inventories
- Students will complete Informational Interviews
- Students will register at OMJ and will have a Backpack
- Students should be able to differentiate between employment options, have knowledge of in-demand jobs and career pathways
- Students should be able to communicate why employment matters, complete the modules and utilize the tools through the Job Seekers Guide
- Students will identify where they are in the career planning process

Job Exploration Counseling is available statewide to students who are Blind or Visually Impaired. This map reflects service areas where providers will deliver services. OOD will update this information as more services become available and/or service areas expand.
