

Pre-Employment Transition Services: **Workplace Readiness Training** Ohio Sight Centers

Learn skills needed for greater independence

- Classroom-based
- Duration: Up to 8 hours
- Population: Students who are Blind or Visually Impaired and need interpersonal and job readiness skills.

Service Outcomes:

- Students will understand appropriate work behaviors and demonstrate the ability to meet employer expectations with regards to timeliness, hygiene, etc
- Students will participate in mock interviews, complete application and resume templates, and when possible attend job fairs
- Students will complete a pre and post evaluation to measure skill attainment
- Students will demonstrate knowledge of the impact of personal social media profile and other communication (i.e. appropriate email address, voicemail message, etc.)

Workplace Readiness Training is available statewide to students who are Blind or Visually Impaired. This map reflects service areas where providers will deliver services. OOD will update this information as more services become available and/or service areas expand.
