Why should I prepare for the ACT and other college entrance exams?

Better scores can mean getting into the college of your choice, more scholarships, more financial aid!

When are the classes?

Students must attend all dates (Saturdays, 10:00am to 2:00 pm): February 19, February 26, March 5, March 12, March 19, and March 26.

I am interested! What do I do?

Due by December 13:

1. Student **application**
2. Parent Information **form**
3. **"I Commit" form**
4. Teacher **recommendation**

Then what happens?

1. A teacher will contact you the week of **December 13** for an interview.
2. If you are selected:
 - a. You will attend a 1-hr orientation session by **February 4**
 - b. You will take the ACT practice test by **February 11**
 - c. Class begins **February 19**
